


Response Form & Household Survey

These will, for example, help judge the actual need for development.

The number of people in each household who are registered as being resident will be issued with a booklet and survey document in an unsealed envelope.

Please arrange to seal your survey document in the envelope provided and post in one of the ballot boxes provided at the Village Shop / Post Office. The Kings Arms or the Parish Hall.

Second home owners in the parish are invited to complete and return the survey. Your preferences will be noted in the development process of the Neighbourhood Plan.

The target date to complete and post your survey document is **22nd March 2016**.

You need not give your name and contact details, but if you do the information you give will be treated in the strictest confidence and be seen only by the persons collating the responses. Having that information will also make it possible to enter you in the PRIZE DRAW to take place on 30th March 2016, in which you could **win £100**.
