



### **Contact – Privacy Notice**

**When you contact us** the personal information you provide (such as name, address, email address, phone number, organisation) will be processed and stored to enable us to contact you and respond to your correspondence, provide information and/or access our facilities and services. Your personal information will be not shared or provided to any other third party.

### **Councillor – Privacy Notice**

**When you sign your acceptance of office** and take your seat on Strete Parish Council the personal information you provide (such as name, address, email address, phone number, register of interests and other relevant information) will be processed and stored so that it is possible to contact you, respond to your correspondence and retain information relating to your time in office with the Council. (The Council asks that you provide a dedicated email address for conducting Council business). Your personal information will not be shared with any third party other than those related to a statutory or lawful requirement or with your consent.

### **The Council's Right to Process Information**

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Article 6 (1) (a) (b) and (e)

- Processing is with consent of the data subject or
- Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation or
- Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller

### **Information Security**

Strete Parish Council has a duty to ensure the security of personal data. We make sure that your information is protected from unauthorised access, loss, manipulation, falsification, destruction or unauthorised disclosure. This is done through appropriate technical measures and appropriate policies. Copies of these policies can be requested. We will only keep your data for the purpose it was collected for, and only for as long as is necessary, after which it will be deleted. You may request the deletion of your data held by Strete Parish Council at any time.

### **Children**

We will not process any data relating to a child under 13 without the express consent of the parent or guardian of the child concerned.

### **Right to be informed about the collection and use of personal data**

Individuals have the right to be informed about the collection and use of their personal data. This is a key transparency requirement under the GDPR. The data controller must provide individuals with information including: the purposes for processing personal data, the retention periods for that personal data, and who it will be shared with. We call this 'privacy information'.

This privacy information will be provided to individuals at the time we collect their personal data from them.

### **Rights Related to Automated Decision Making and Profiling**

Strete Parish Council does not use any form of automated decision-making or the profiling of individual personal data.

### **Right to data portability**

This allows individuals to obtain and reuse their personal data for their own purposes and across different services.
